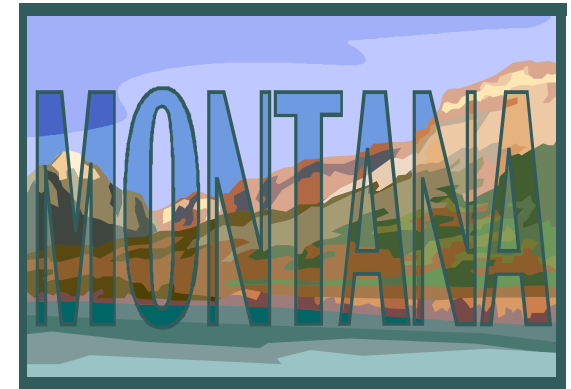

CMA is not a Christian club or ride group designed to segregate Christians from the influences of the world. It is a ministry designed to thrust you into the mission of spreading the light of Jesus into the motorcycling community.

**WHAT IS CMA?** The main purpose of this ministry is to share the Gospel with motorcyclists. This is achieved by attending motorcycle events, rallies, and/or tours, developing relationships, & offering our support and skills as servants and conducting worship services.

## **What CMA offers you.**

1. By combining our love for the Lord and motorcycling, CMA offers a great opportunity for **fellowship** with other members and CMA chapters through Christian rallies, rides, and meetings. Our proven experience in the field of “highway and byway” evangelism has been used to develop **training** through our Seasons of Refreshing Conferences and Ministry Team Program.

## **What CMA asks of you.**

The only requirement to be a member is that you be a Christian, having accepted Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior. This lifestyle of the Lordship of Jesus Christ would define personal, doctrinal, and moral decisions by the Bible. After joining CMA, you must complete CMA's Ministry Team training to wear the CMA back patch. We ask that your walk and testimony honor our Lord Jesus Christ and cause others to desire that which God has done in you. We realize there are many levels of interest and involvement. Prayerfully consider how you want to be involved. Any Christian ministry with a strong foundation depends on people **committed** to its cause and **consistent** in their physical, prayerful, and financial support.

CMA is supported by individual gifts. We do not bombard mailboxes begging for money. We motivate by vision. Our existence depends entirely upon the prayerful freewill contributions of the CMA membership. Ten percent of the undesignated income is given to other ministries to help spread the Gospel. One hundred percent of the funds raised through the Run for the Son, CMA's annual benefit ride, go to missions.
